

Extraordinary Women of Kawartha Lakes Awards

Recognizing women who have made an extraordinary contribution to the improvement of the quality of life in our community

CATEGORY: EXTRAORDINARY WOMEN - MENTOR

Nominee who is a guide, a role model to others, who offers support and encourages people to grow in order that they may maximize their potential, develop their skills, improve their performance and become the person they want to be. An influential sponsor or supporter of day to day questions, life choices or workplace nurturing, and encourages new creative thinking.

MANDATORY CRITERIA: Nominee must meet each of these points

- ✓ Must be 18 years or older
- ✓ Must be a resident of CKL
- ✓ If employed must work in CKL as primary location
- ✓ Nominees may be nominated in only one category per year
- ✓ Nominations must include 2 references (not from family members)
- ✓ Nominators may be non-profit organizations, service clubs, churches, business associations or individuals

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD CRITERIA:

- Nominee is an experienced and trusted advisor
- Nominee can be a parent, guardian, Elder, coworker, teacher, or caring adult
- Nominee has developed programs that enhance life skills for others
- Nominee has created women's networking circles to help others in CKL

TELL US ABOUT YOUR NOMINEE: (Minimum of 100 words/Maximum 1000 words).

Please consider the following question when telling us about your Nominee.

- How has the nominee demonstrated being a role model to others in CKL
- How has the nominee reached out to women across CKL and inspire them?
- Is the nominee approachable, making herself available and has the ability to listen?
- How does the nominee demonstrate a commitment to promoting ongoing learning and growth?
- How has the community benefited from her extraordinary mentorship?
- Is the Nominee is a guide who can help others find the right direction and who can help them to develop solutions?
- Has the Nominee had similar experiences to gain an empathy with an understanding of their issues?

AWARD SELECTION PROCESS:

- Nominations received will be reviewed by a nominations committee for completeness and basic eligibility.
- References will be checked.
- Award recipients will be selected by a Selection Panel consisting of award sponsors, a member of the Board of Directors of Women's Resources and an EW Committee member.
- The Panel reserves the right to change the nomination category if appropriate.
- Recipients in all categories will be announced at the EW Awards Gala evening.
